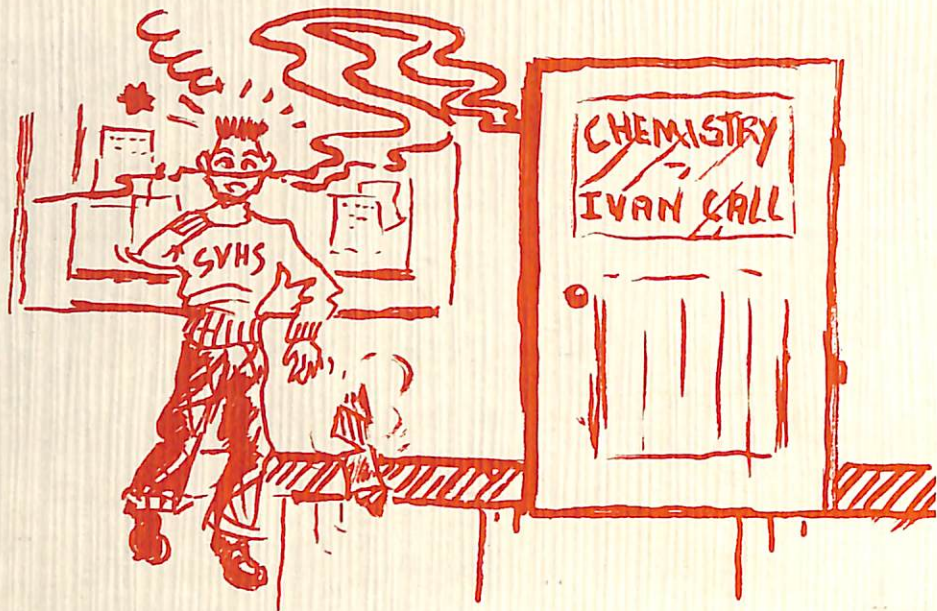

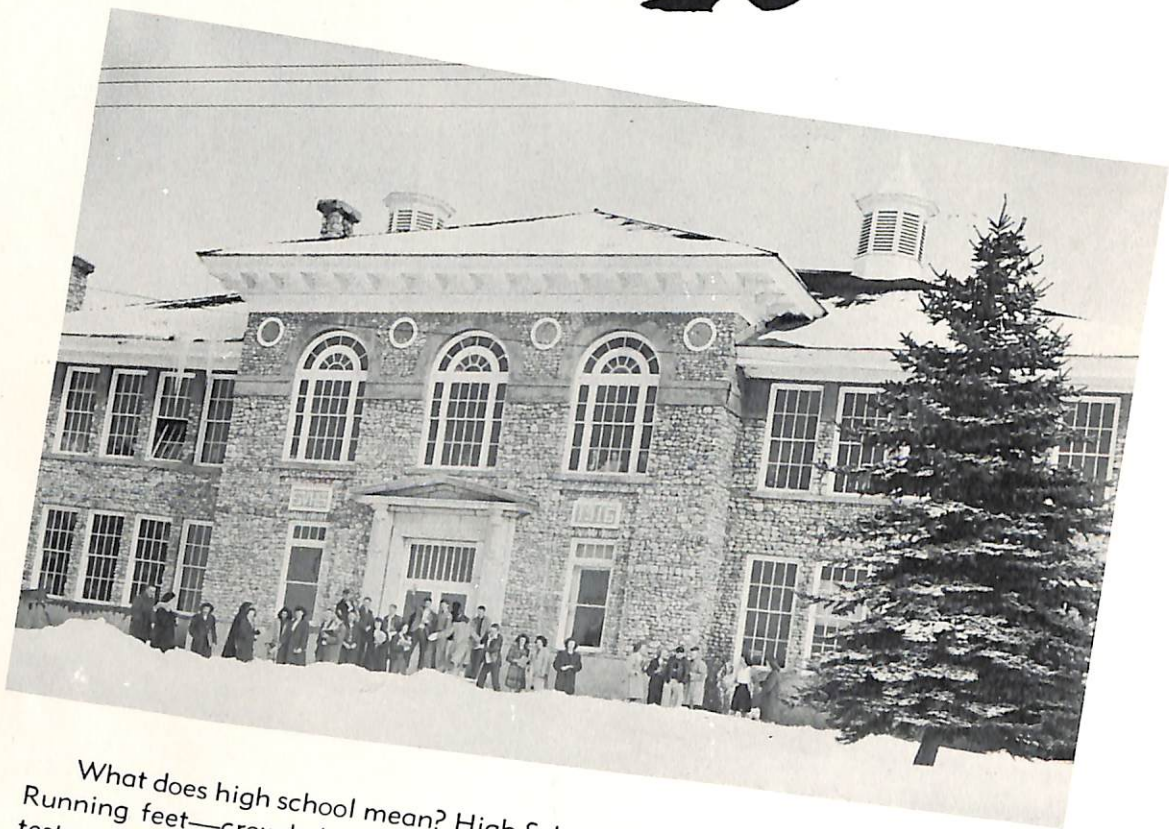

life-loving, life-living, carefree days of youth.

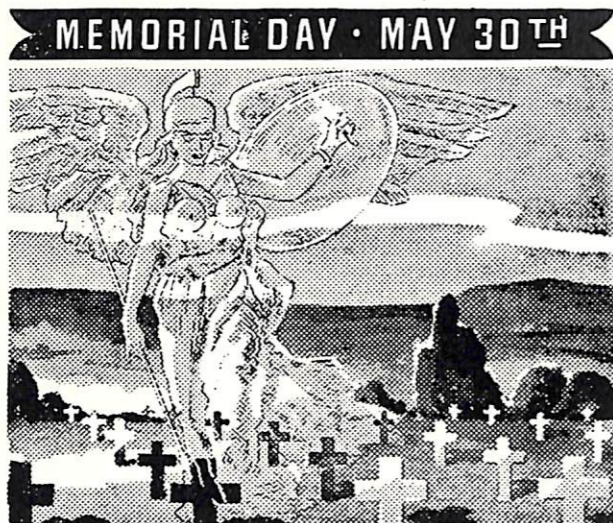
It is the wish of the staff that with this little book, the Sta Va Hi, you may

These clubs are nationally sponsored and both send representatives to State Conventions.

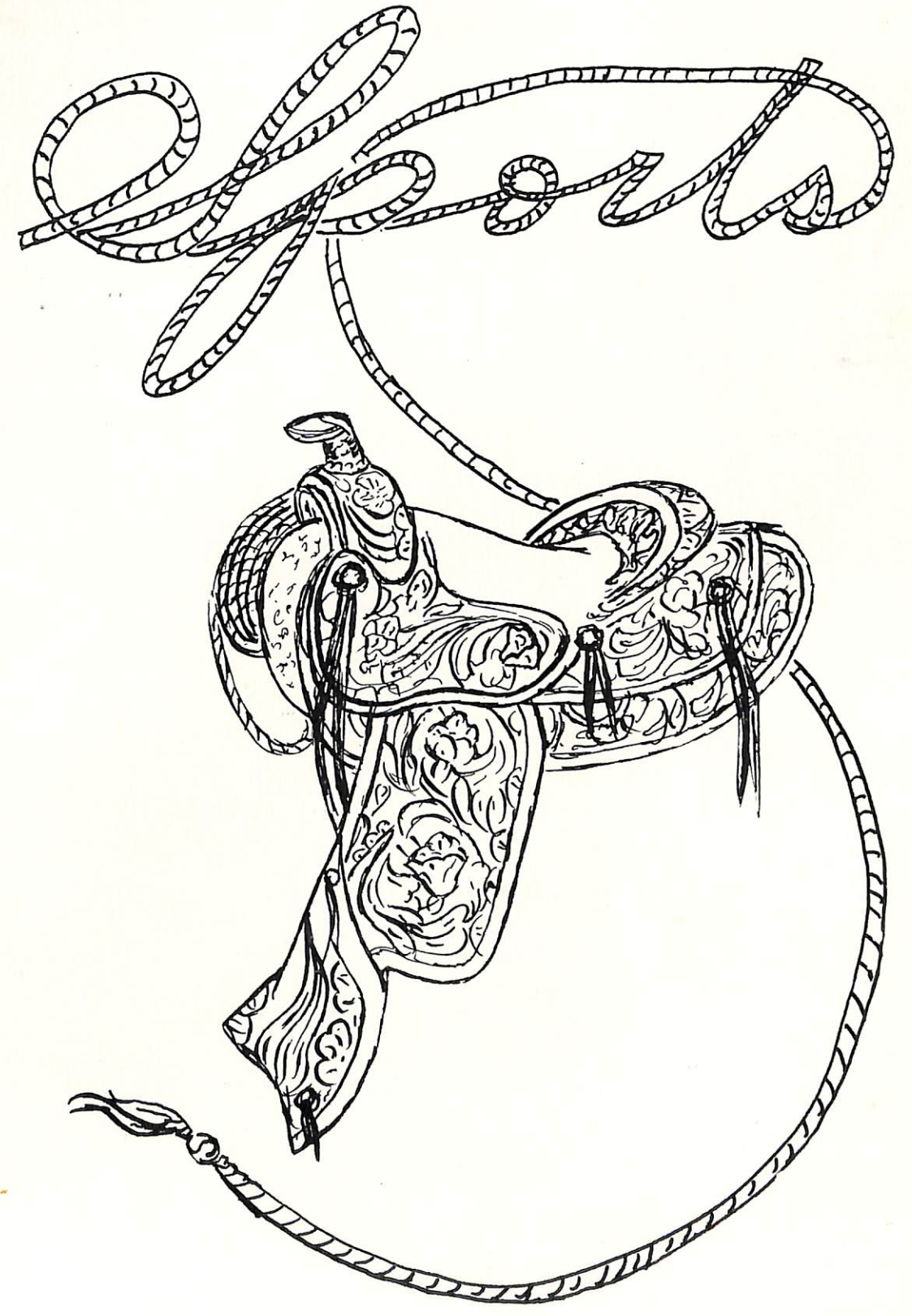
They hold regular meetings and have several parties each year attended by the members of both clubs.

The Home Ec. Club annually stuff the cows for their "Barn Dance." The F.F.A. hold a father and sons banquet each year for all the members and their fathers.



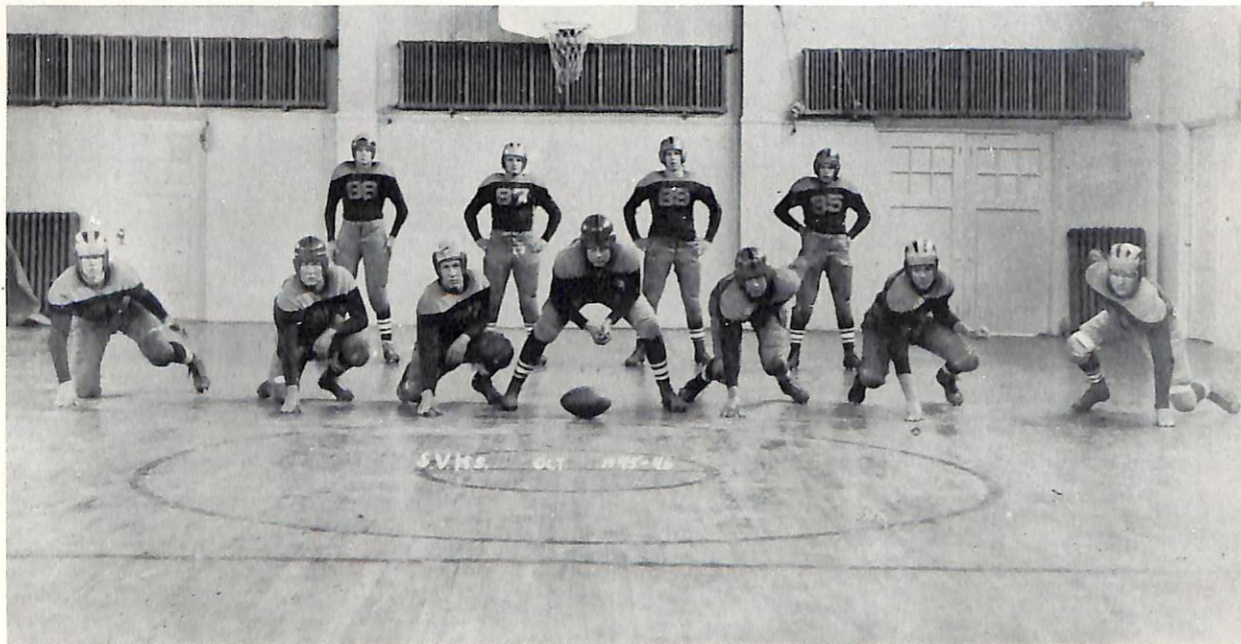
