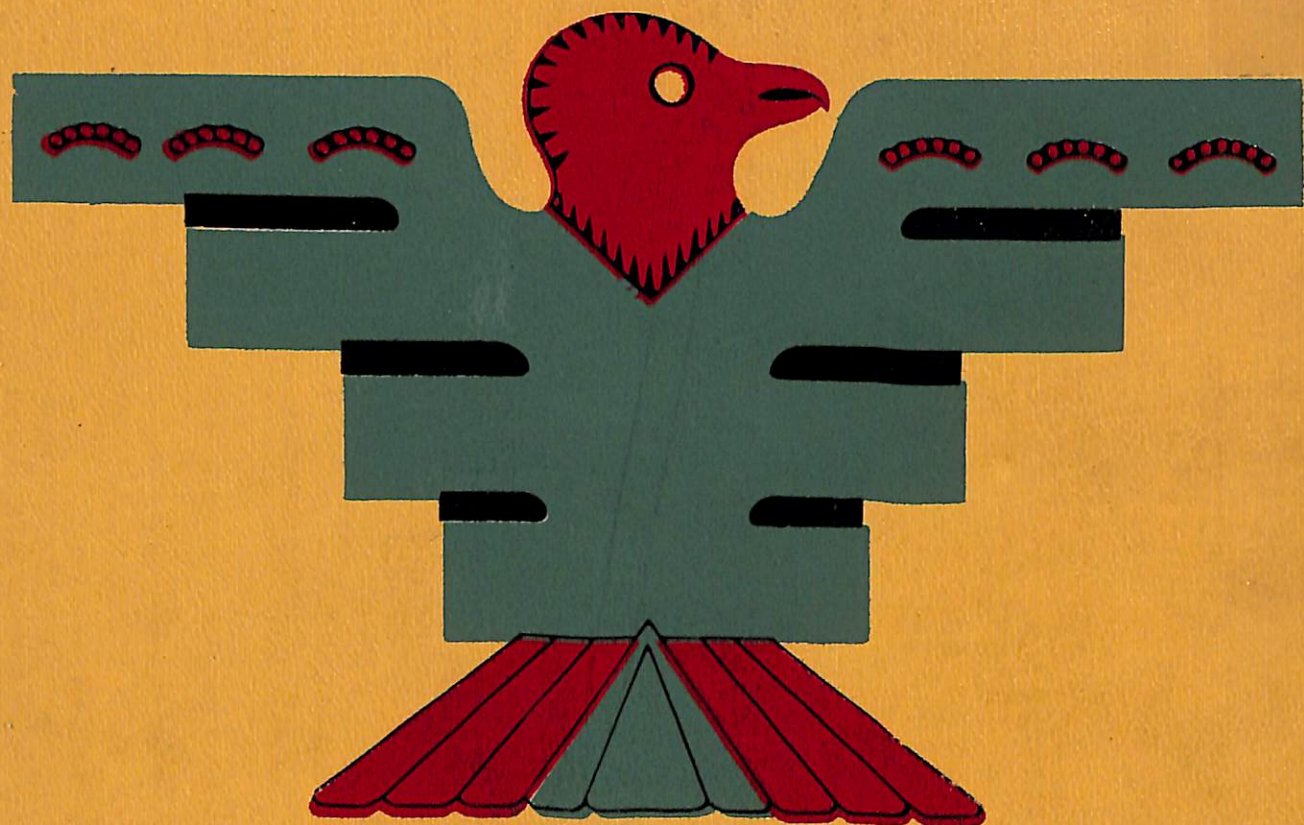
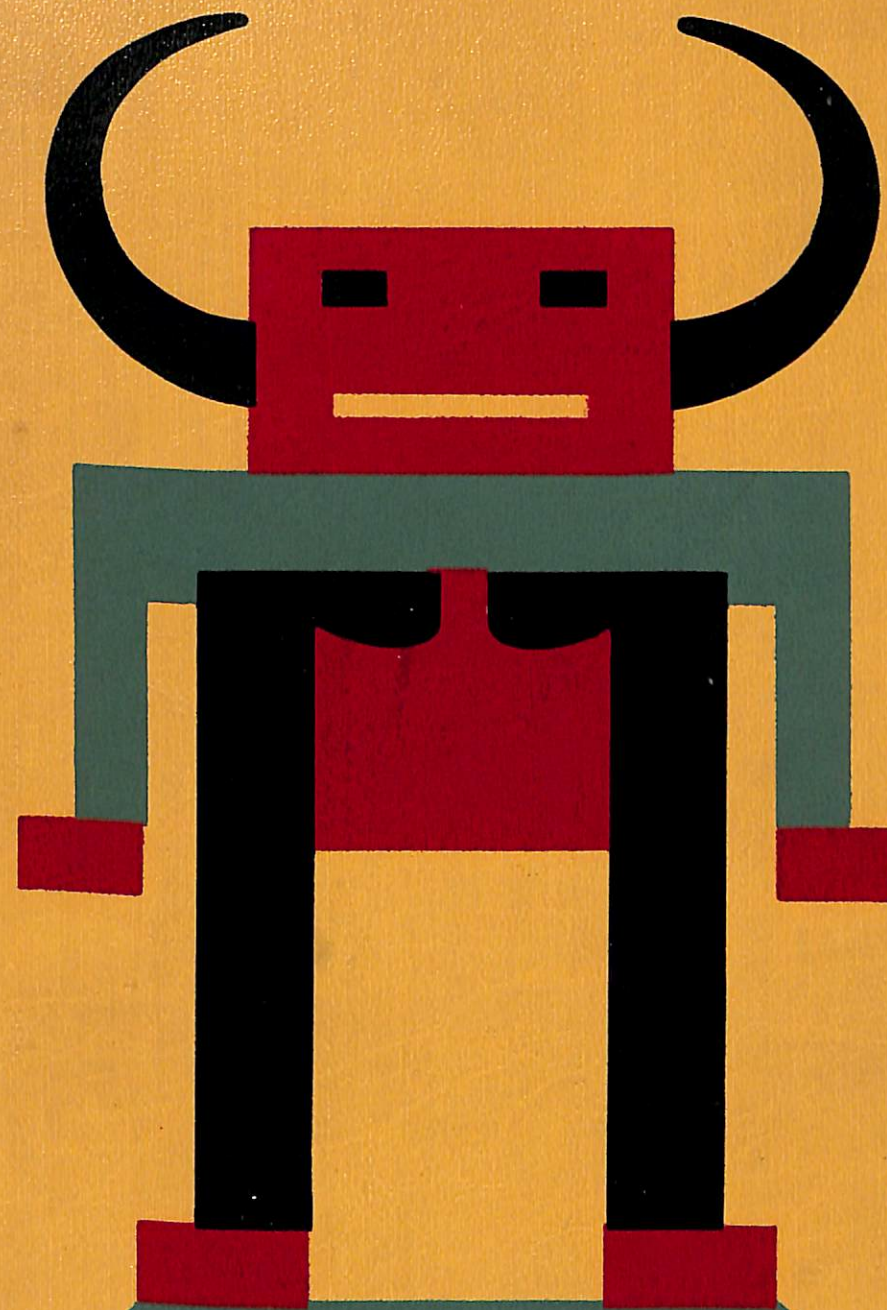


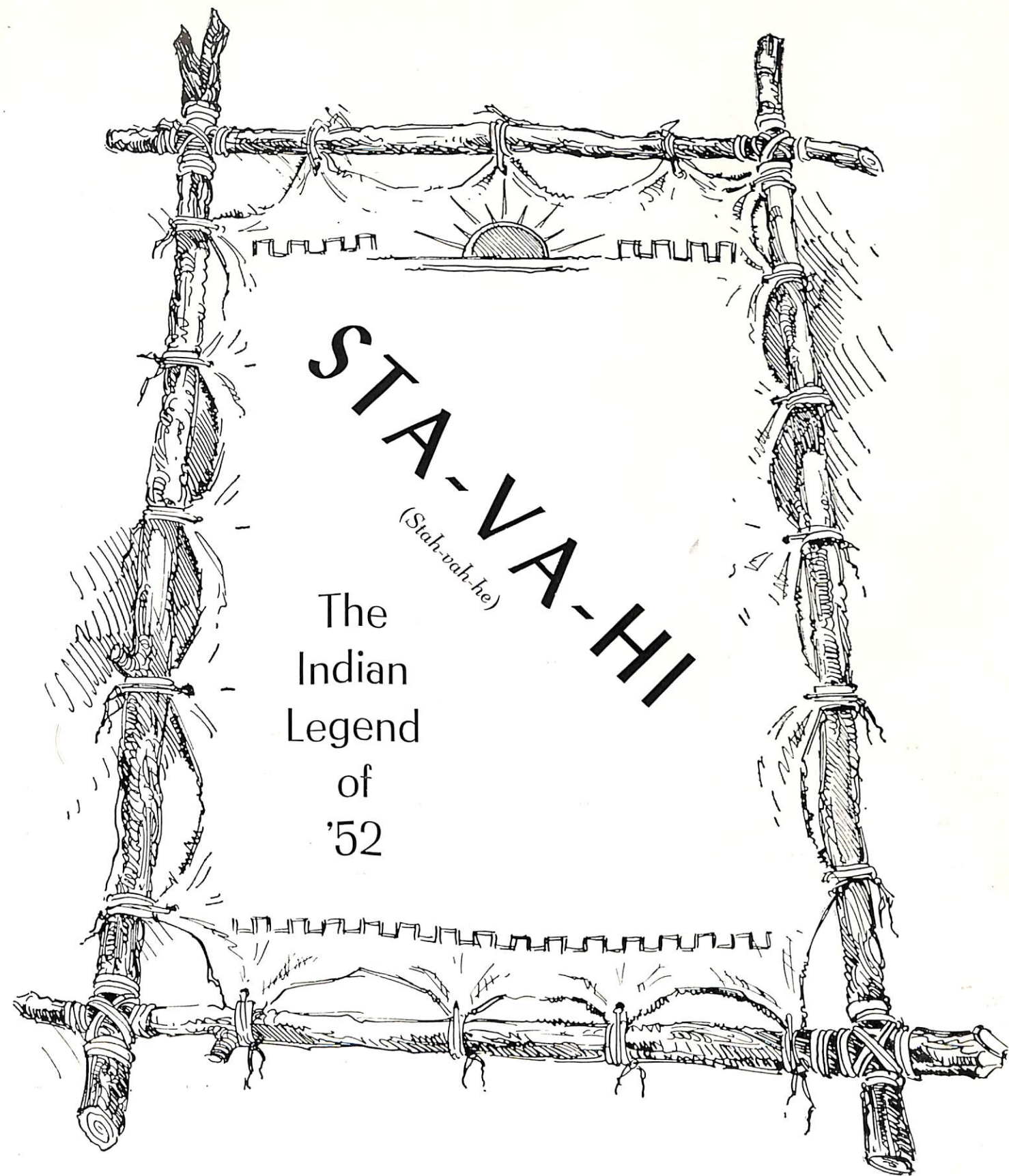

Keeping peace within their hearts."

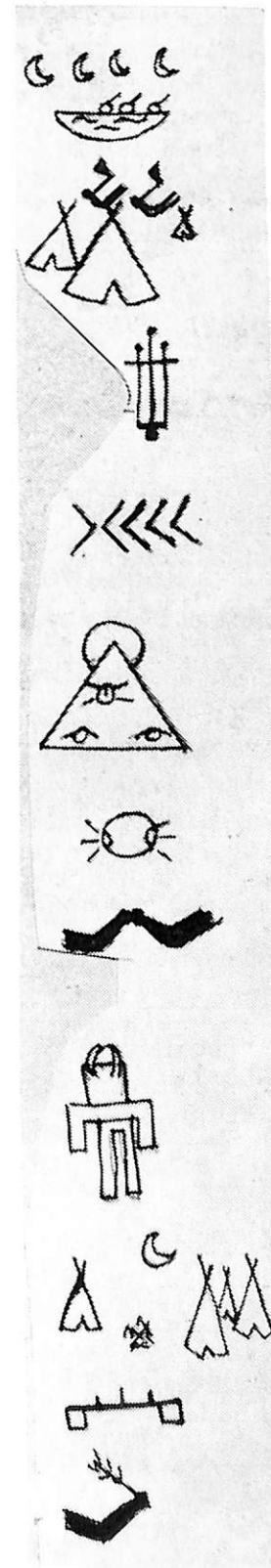
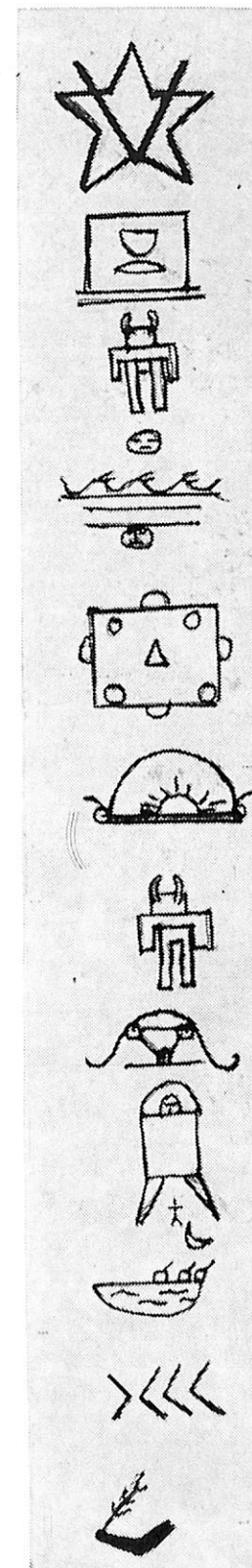
Thus then spoke the Great White Spirit;

Even as he guides you now.

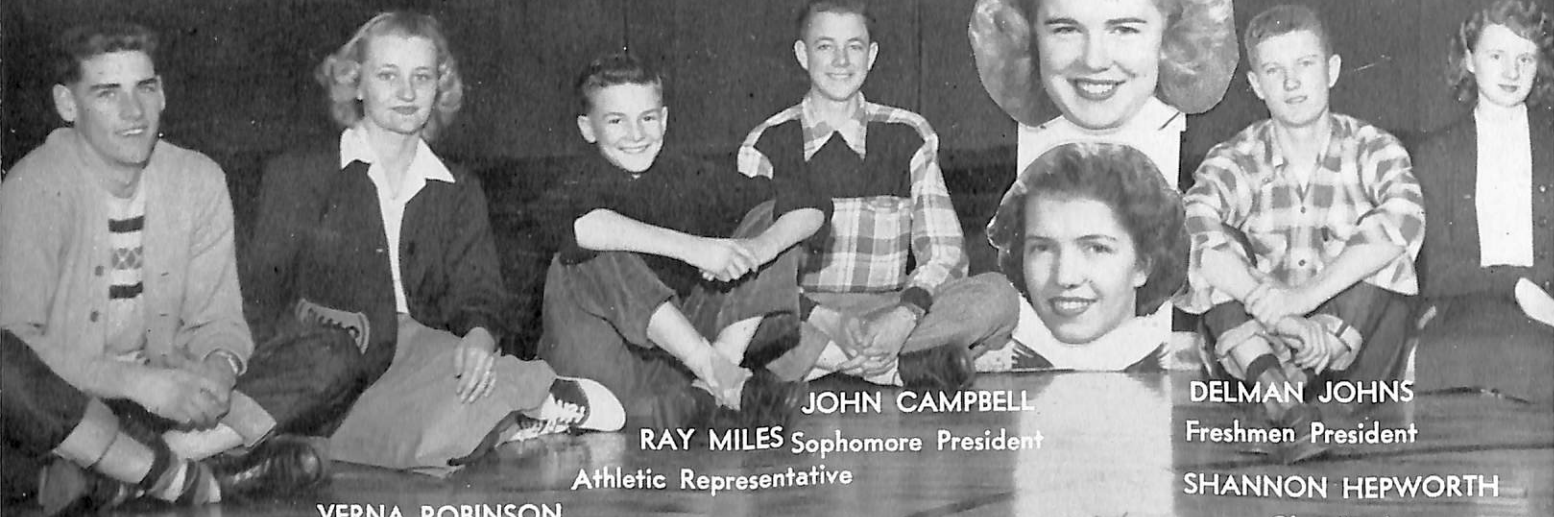
This new moon we sent new warriors
