The rain and snow beat down upon you, but year after year you turn green and produce fields of grain.


Your patchwork hills yield and feed us.


Tuneful, melodious airs were floating through the halls of Sta-Va-Hi as talented musicians met at Afton for the annual West Green River Inter-school Concert.

They go steadily forward with an eye to the future and the development of Star Valley High School.






#### STORY OF THE PLAY
