SUPERINTENDENT'S MESSAGE

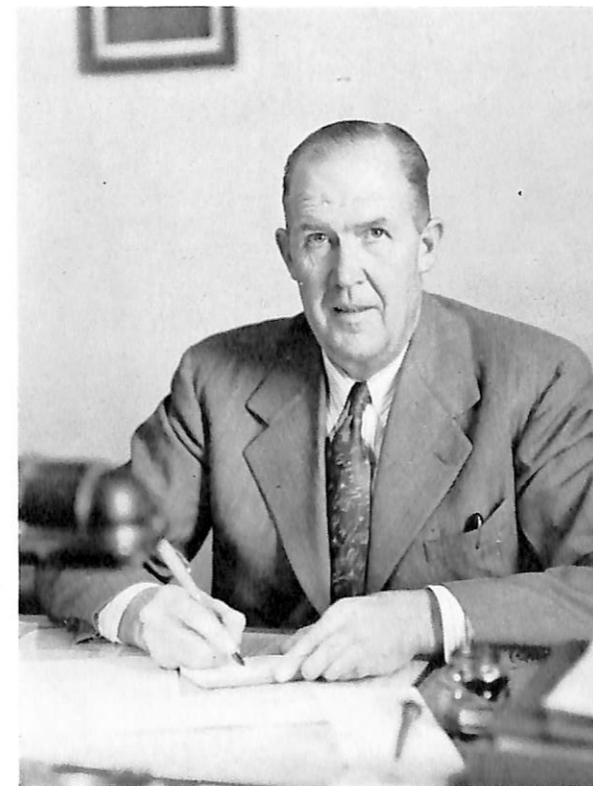
