and gold of a great hero

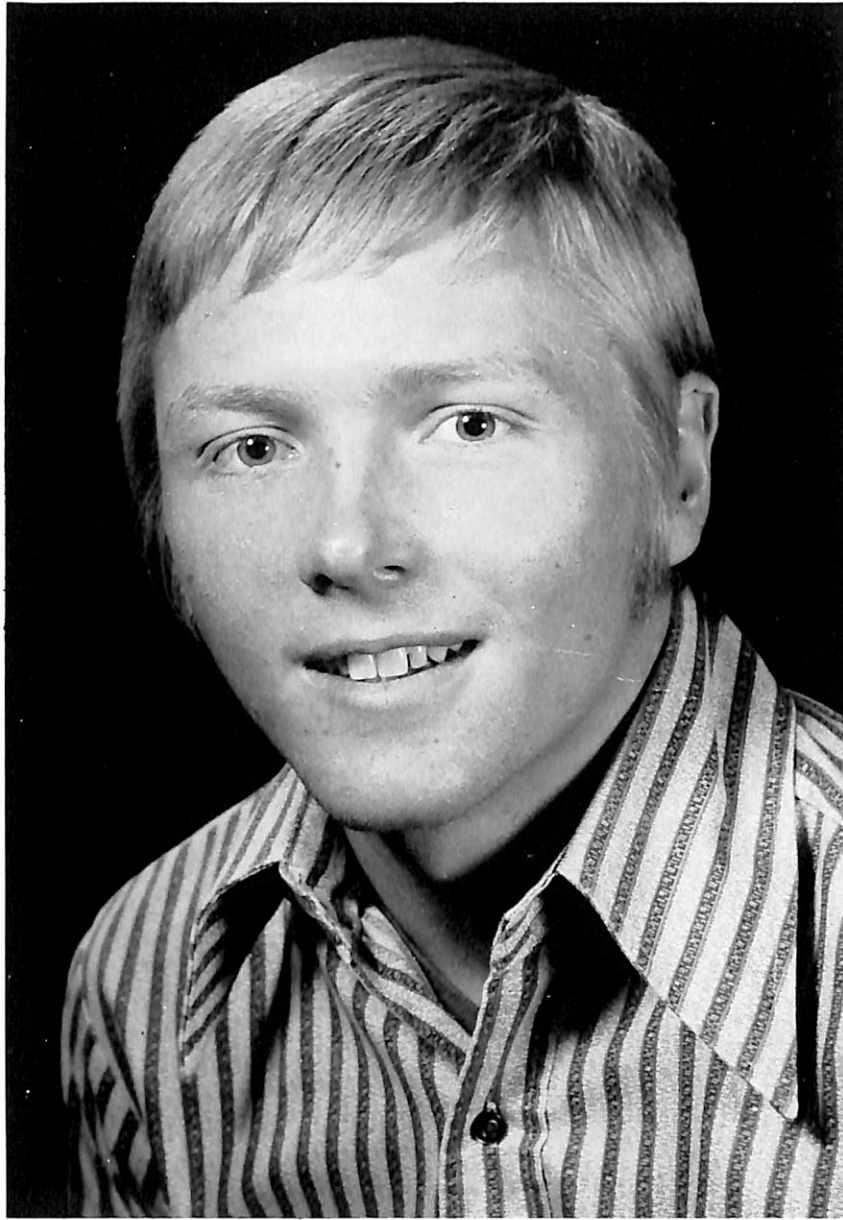
Or covered with the blue and

where life is taught.

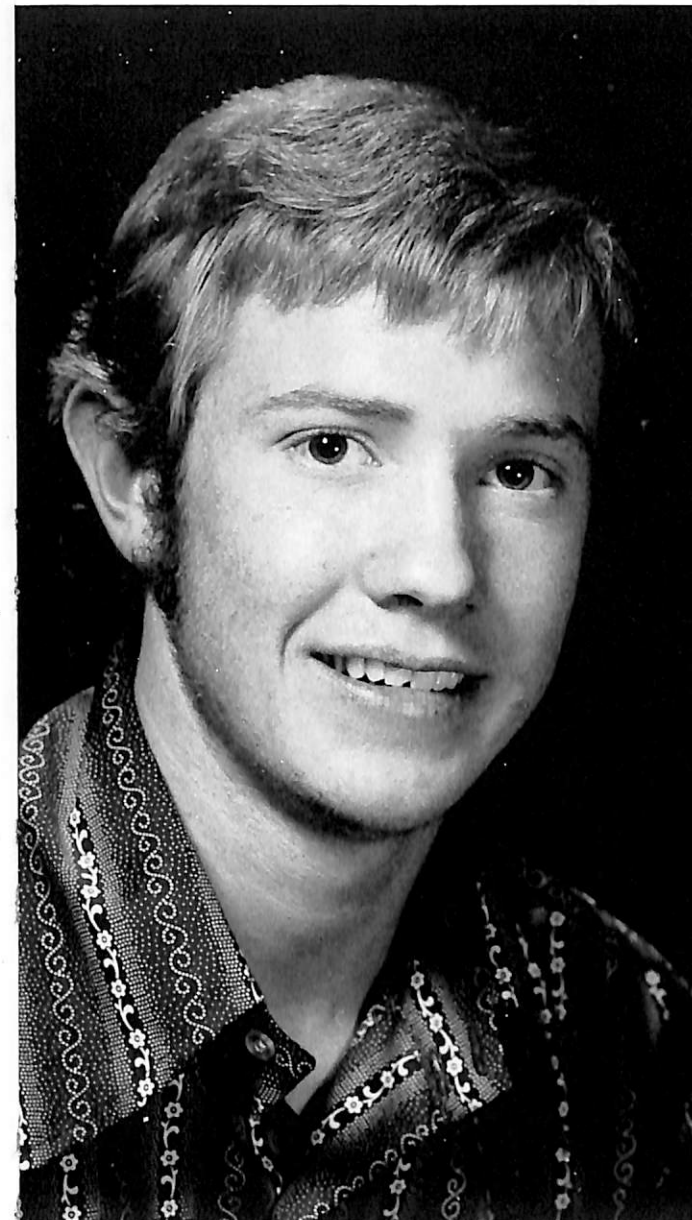

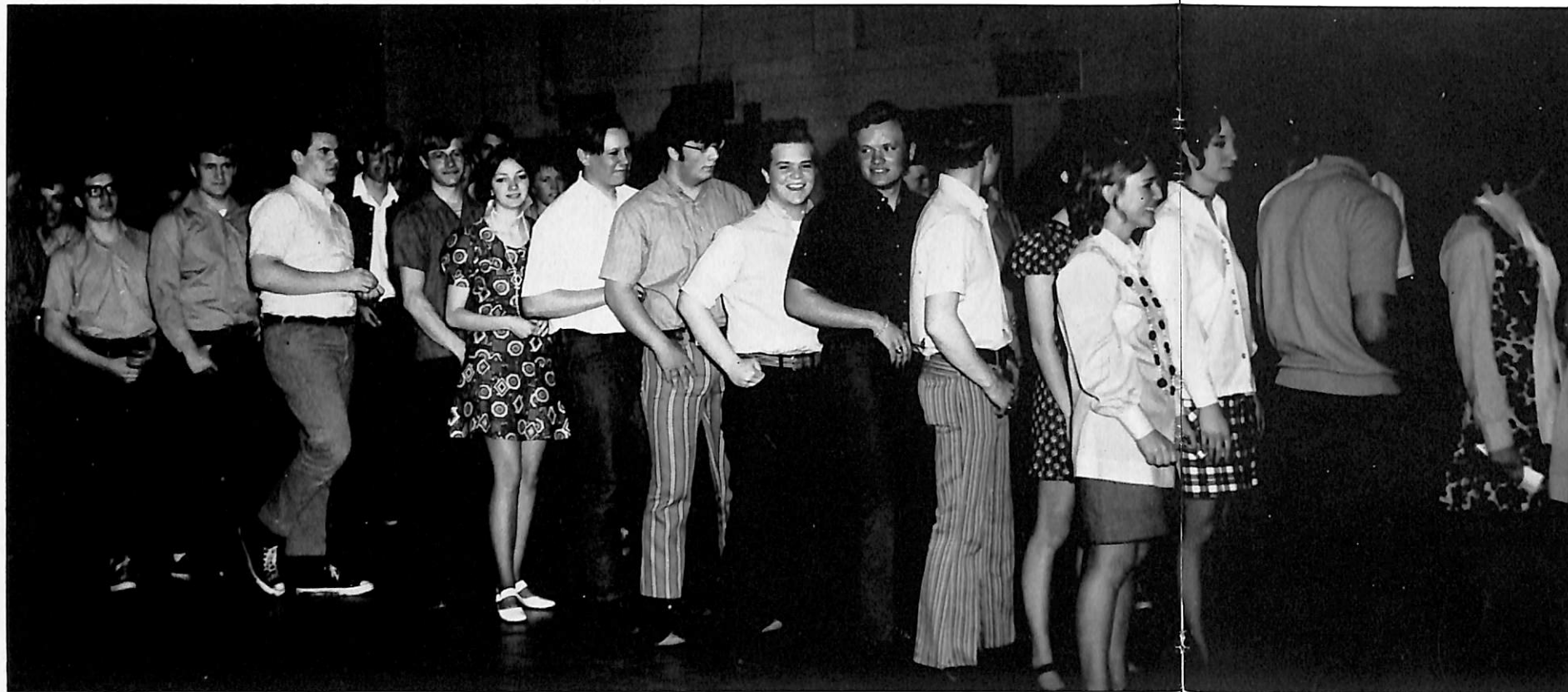

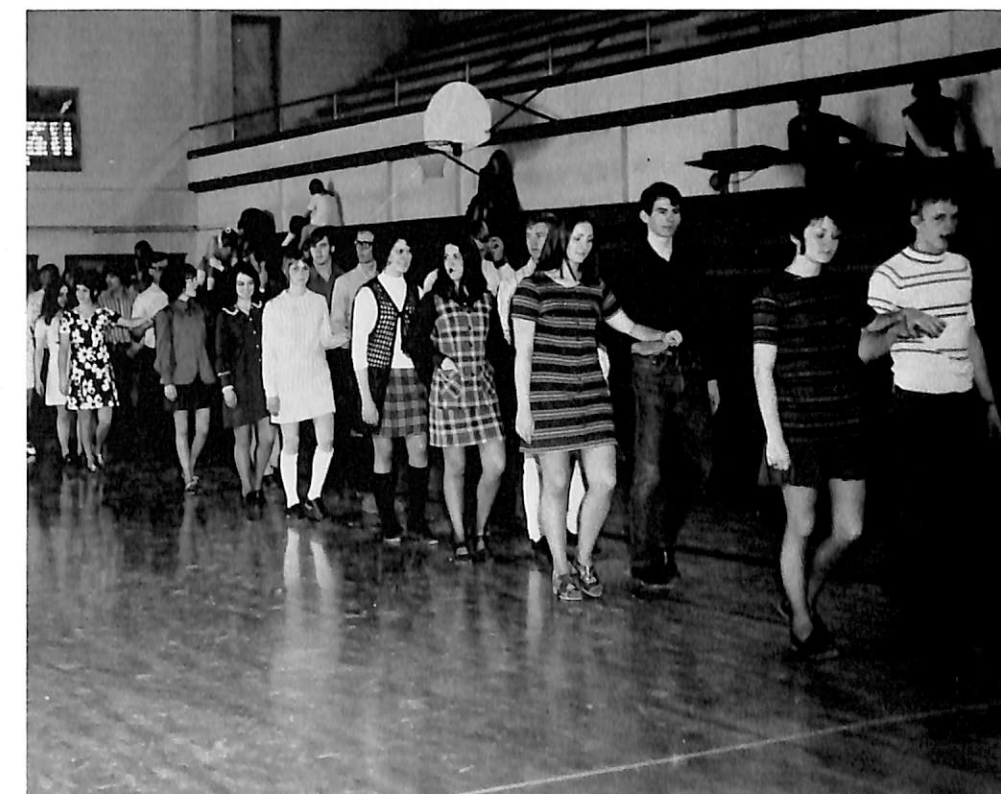

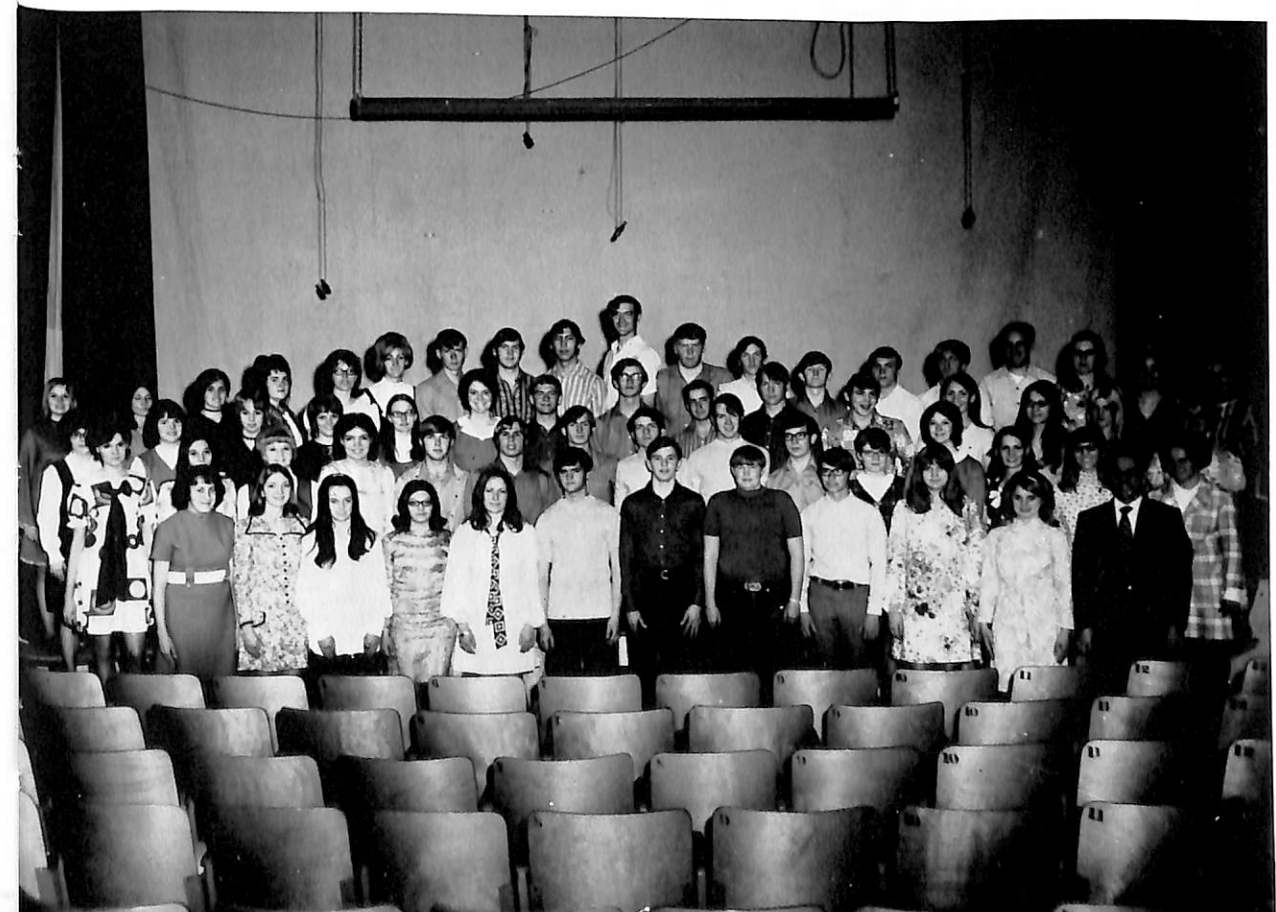

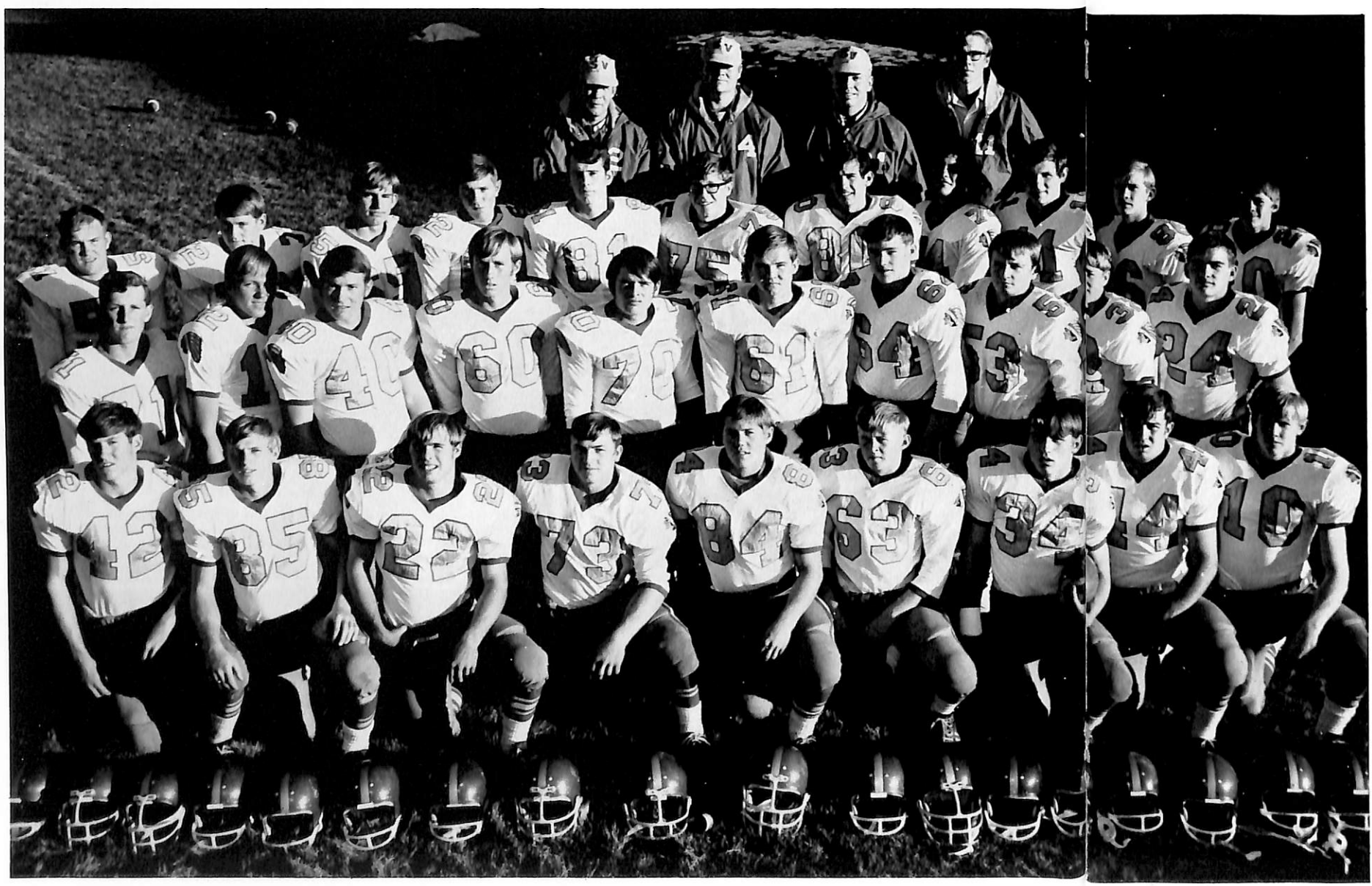

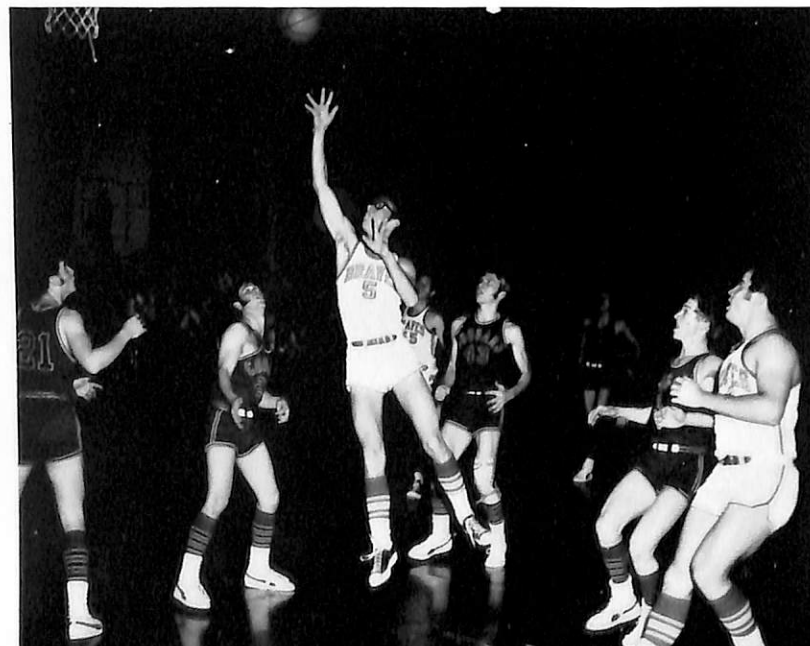
Basketball

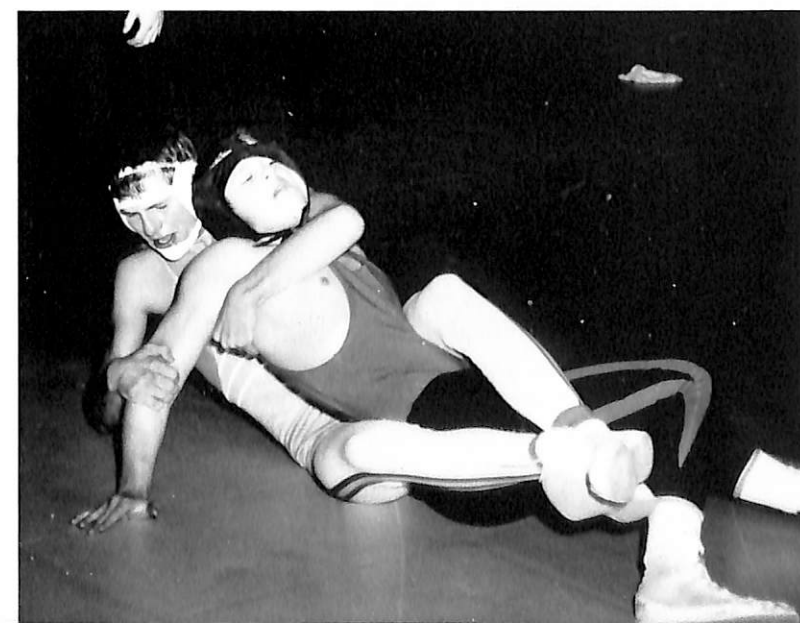

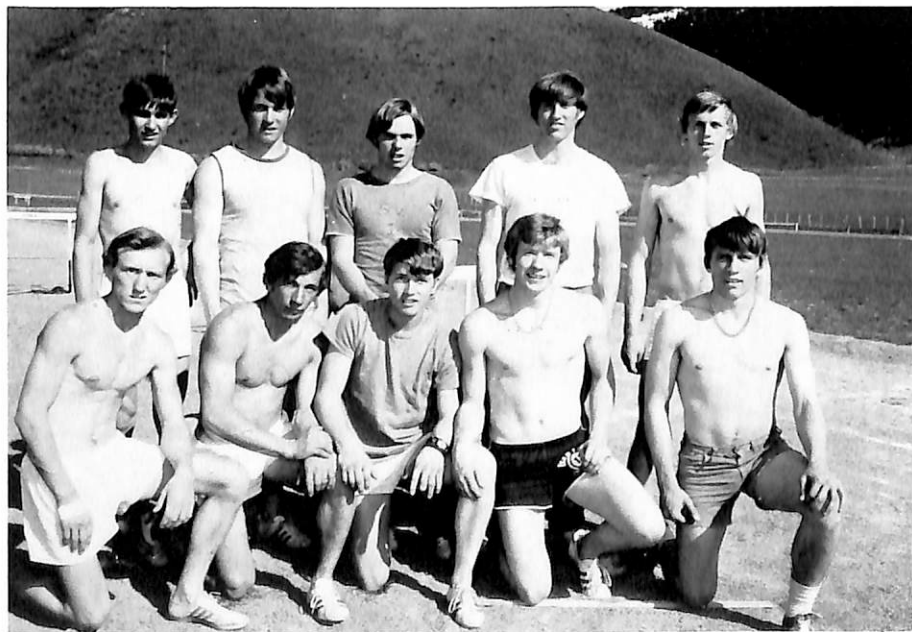
State Track Champs

The S.V. track team after four years of long and miserable rebuilding finally found the pot at the end of the rainbow. Under the direction of coaches Hillstead and Luthi and through many long hours of work the Braves ran away with the district title and then nipped Torrington for the state title. Kevin Hyde set a new state record in the two-mile run and Kevin Croft and David Pendleton won the 880 yd. and 100 yd. dash mile relay took firsts at state. Darnell Jackson, Curt Stock, Lynn Hillstead, Michael Haderlie, and Doug Jenkins also placed high in the state meet. As a whole a total of 17 boys qualified for the state meet.

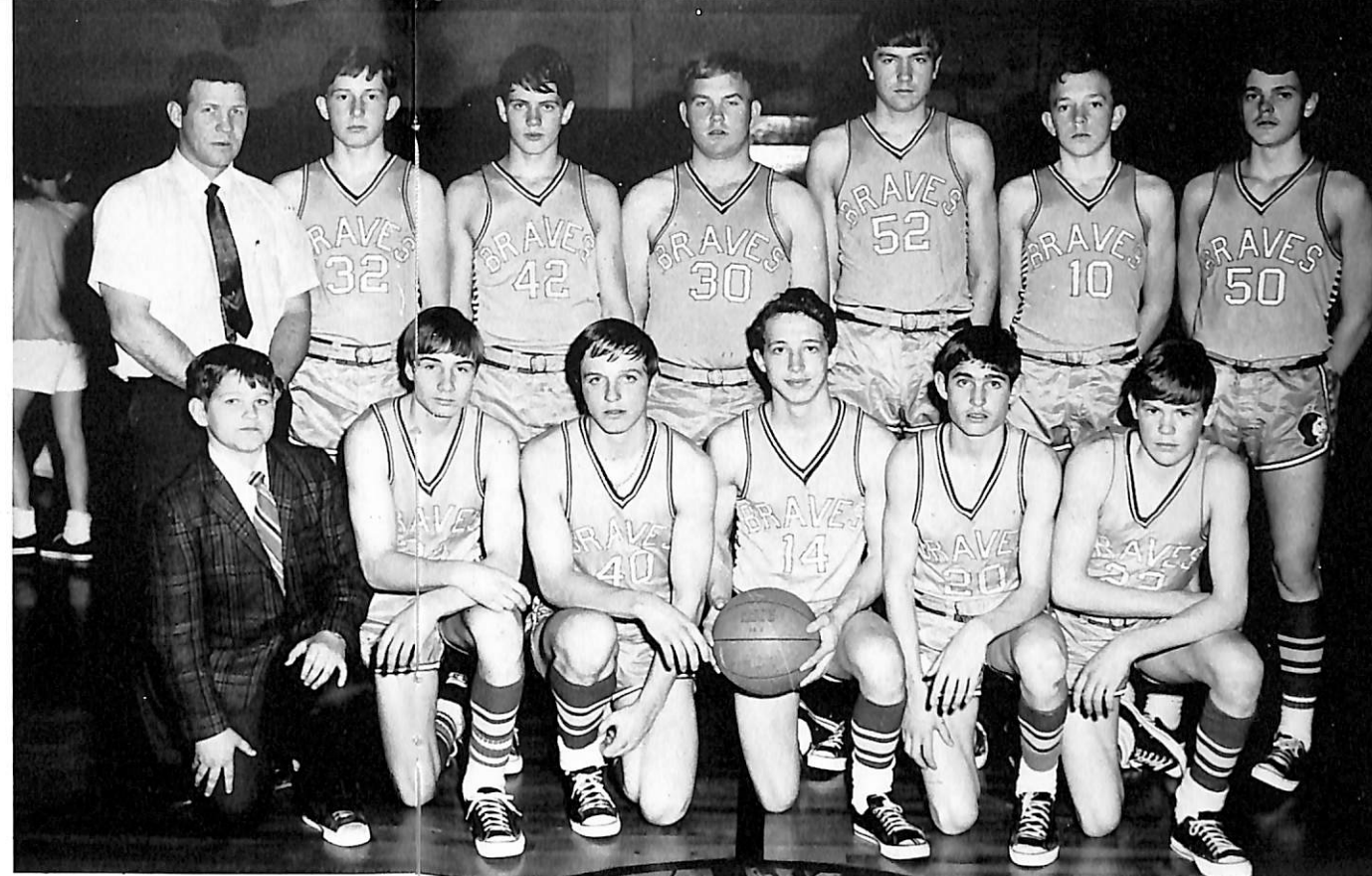

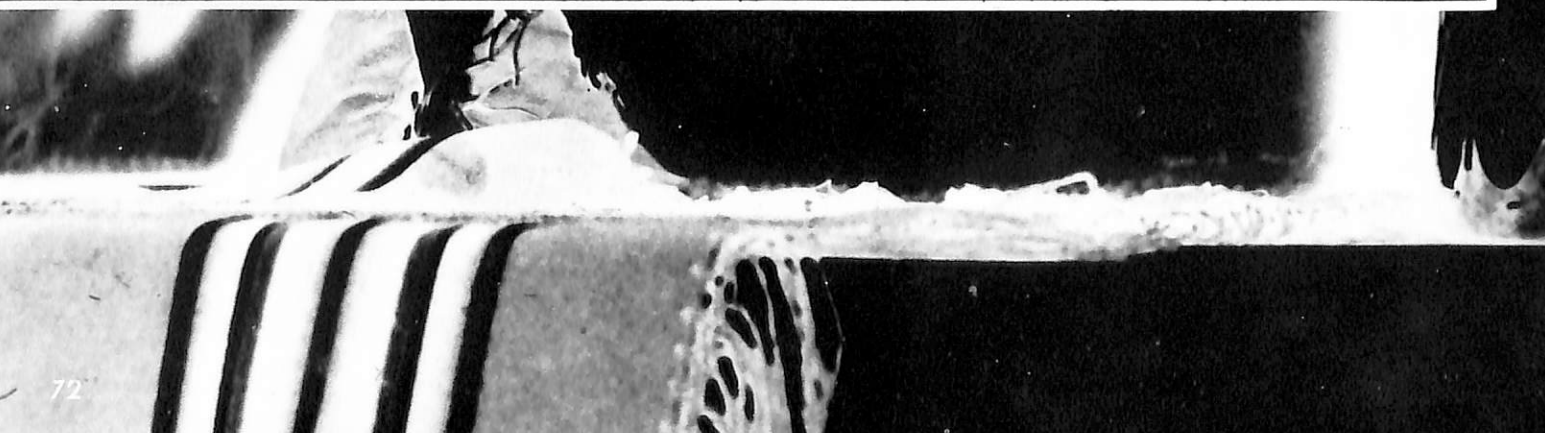
